

# LVCHS DRESS CODE

## **Non-Chapel Days:**

- Solid color polo or button-down shirts.
- Any pants except sweatpants, pants with holes, or tight fitting pants.
- Any modest skirt (girls only).
- LVCHS Athletic Warm-up, navy or black Blazer, LVCHS Hoodie, any appropriate red, black or gray sweatshirt, any navy, black or gray sweater.

## **Chapel Days: (Dress Up - no jeans, polos, or sweatshirts):**

- Girls are encouraged to wear modest skirts, and dresses with sleeves; if not, a modest shirt with sleeves must be worn with dress pants.
- Boys must wear a button down shirt; ties are encouraged but optional.
- Any sweaters that match the dressed up outfit may be worn.
- Dress down passes (shorts, jeans, etc) cannot be used.

## **Daily**

Casual or dressy footwear may be worn. Neat athletic shoes and sandals with heel straps are permitted. All shoes worn at school must have a back or heel strap. Flip-flops and athletic slides are not permitted. Excessively high heels are discouraged for safety reasons.

Hats may not be worn in the building during normal school hours.

Hair can only be colored a natural color. Hairstyles, like “mohawks”, that draw excessive attention to one’s physical appearance and distract others are not permissible.

Appropriate undergarments must be worn at all times. Undergarments must not be visible.

## **For Girls:**

Length of dresses and skirts is to be no more than 3” off the floor when kneeling.

Leggings may only be worn under skirts/dresses - not as pants.

Shirts may not be tied or banded.

Girls must have a hairstyle that reflects their femininity.

A maximum of three ear posts or rings per ear are allowed.

Other visible body piercing and/or tattoos are not permissible.

## **For Boys:**

Button down shirts must be tucked in at the waist.

Boys’ hair must be neatly cut and short enough not to be deemed feminine. For sake of reference, boys’ hair may not extend over the shirt collar and/or over the eyebrows.

Visible piercing or tattoos of any kind are not permissible.

PE uniforms are standard for all students. The PE shorts and t-shirts will be purchased at the school from the PE instructor during the first weeks of school.
